Why choose Barind Medical College (BMC)?

Beautiful Campus

The campus of Barind Medical College & Hospital is extended over an area of 3 acres (approx.) of land situated in the beautiful, calm and quiet, and well communicated location of Rajshahi city. Three multi-storied building, two for academic and one for hospital have already constructed with floor space 1,74,000 square feet with all educational facilities.

High Quality Education

Faculty is enriched with highly qualified, experienced and dedicated teachers with academic, clinical and research expertise.

Exposure to Patients

Students are exposing to patients in indoor, outdoor and emergency department as a part of their regular clinical teaching and learning process. Besides the students are placed for one month in UHC (Upazilla Health Complex) as a part of the curriculum. This allows students an opportunity to practice communication, interviewing and data gathering skills, as well as Clinical examination and patient assessment techniques in rural and urban population.

Assessment & Promotion

Evaluation of students are done through on going (designed card), periodic, formative and summative assessments including written SAQ & MCQ, Oral as SOE, Practical with OSPE & OSCE. First Professional MBBS Examination will be held at the end of 1½ years. Second Professional MBBS Examination will be held at the end of 2½ years. Third Professional MBBS Examination will be held at the end of 3½ years. Final Professional MBBS Examination will be at the end of 5 years. Students will be promoted after passing the relevant Professional examinations. All Professional Examination's will be held on and from 1st working day of May and November each year.

Class & Working Hours

From Saturday to Thursday class starts at 07.30 h and continues up to 14.30 h followed by hour of clinical teaching in the Hospital for clinical students in the evening.

Eligibility for Appearing in the professional Examinations :

- ☒ Certificate from the respective head of departments regarding students obtaining at least 75% attendance in all classes (theory, practical, tutorial, residential field practice, clinical placement etc.) during the phase.
- ☒ Obtaining at least 60% marks in examinations.
- ☒ No student shall be allowed to appear in the professional examinations unless the student passes in all subjects of the previous professional examinations.

Pass Marks :

Pass marks is 60%. Student shall have to pass written (MCQ + SAQ + formative), oral practical and clinical examination separately.

Curriculum

Curriculum for MBBS Course approved by the Bangladesh Medical and Dental Council (BM&DC) adopted by the Faculty of Medicine, University of Rajshahi & Rajshahi Medical University. On Successful completion of 5 years academic study, University of Rajshahi and Rajshahi Medical University will award MBBS degree.

Admission

🔄 Bangladeshi Students

🔄 **Time of entrance** : Depends upon the decision of government at the end of each year.

🔄 Open for application

From September (Subject to change the admission time schedule declared by the Directorate General of Health Services (DGHS), Bangladesh.

🔄 Eligibility

As decided by the Directorate General of Health Services (DGHS), Bangladesh.

🔄 **Procedure** : Students must follow the national policy by appearing central admission test arranged by the DGHS, Bangladesh.

1. Application for admission must be submitted online in the prescribed format available at the website www.bmc.edu.bd. Detailed Information is available there.

2. All Information regarding admission in the 1st year MBBS course will be notified on the notice board and website of Barind Medical College.

International Students

🔄 Time of entrance

At the end of each year, usually, September - December each year.

🔄 Open for application

As decided by the Directorate General of Health Services (DGHS), usually May to November each year.

🔄 Eligibility

- 🔹 Applicants must have passed qualifying examinations i.e. Higher Secondary Certificate (HSC)/ 'A' level or equivalent examination.
- 🔹 Secondary School Certificate (SSC)/ 'O' level or equivalent examination passed not before 2016.
- 🔹 HSC / 'A' level or equivalent examination passed not before 2018.
- 🔹 Minimum aggregate GPA in SSC/ 'O' level or equivalent and HSC/ 'A' level or equivalent : 7.00 (Seven)

- ◆ Minimum GPA either in SSC/ 'O' level or equivalent and in HSC/'A' level or equivalent : 3.00
- ◆ Minimum GPA in biology : 3.50
- ◆ For calculation of GPA against the marks obtained in SSC/ 'O' level or equivalent exam only top 5 subjects are considered. Therefore, GPA in 'O' level = (total marks obtained in top five subjects)/5
- ◆ Optional subject shall be considered if GPA is below 5 (five)
- ◆ For calculation of GPA against the marks obtained in HSC/ 'A' level or equivalent exam, only 3 subjects (Physics, Chemistry and Biology) are considered. Qualifying grade in each subject individually is "C". Therefore, GPA in 'A' level = (total marks obtained in three subjects)/3.

Procedure

Application for admission must be submitted in the prescribed form available at the Bangladesh Embassy/High Commission and also online: www.bmc.edu.bd in Triplicate along with all certificates, mark sheets/transcripts, copy of passport, 6 passport size photographs and application fee deposit receipt memo to Bangladesh embassy/High commission and the Ministry of Foreign Affairs. Each applicant must send US\$ 70.00 (Seventy) as non refundable application fee by Telegraphic Transfer (T T), payable to the 'Director, Medical Education & HMPD, DGHS, Mohakhali, Dhaka, Bangladesh', A/c No. 20024894, Rupali Bank Ltd Mohakhali Branch, Dhaka. All certificates and mark sheets should be authenticated and attested by the authorized authority like Foreign Ministry of student's country of origin and respective Bangladesh, mission abroad/respective Mission based in Dhaka.

Medical Fitness

All applicants provisionally selected for admission will undergo medical examination and only fit candidates will be eligible for admission.

Quality Assurance Scheme (QAS):

Prohibition of Ragging

Ragging and any type of misconduct towards any student either in the college campus, hostel or outside will be considered as punishable offence and will be immediately reported to the college authority or police if needed. Perpetrators will be punished. Student and parents shall, at the time of admission, furnish an affidavit to the effect that the student shall not indulge in ragging,

College Rules:

- ◆ All students are to carry their "Identity Cards" when in college.
- ◆ All students should attend class in clean and well pressed white aprons with their name plate on the left front side of the apron, shoes for male students.
- ◆ Any sort of political activities are strictly prohibited in the college campus and hostels. If a student of the college takes part in any political activities, unauthorized demonstration, acts or conducts him self/herself in an unbecoming manner or in such manner as would interfere with the academic environment of the college, the authority of the college may take any action deems proper or refer him/her to the College Academic Council /College Disciplinary Committee as needed. Disciplinary action will be taken against the involved students.
- ◆ No student shall address a Press Conference, nor write to the press on the political or related subject or matters concerned directly with the administration of the College, University or any Government or Educational Institution in Bangladesh or abroad No poster or banners or human chain shall be put up without the approval of the Principal. The students who will violate the rules, will be punished.
- ◆ No society or club may be set up by the students nor any meeting held in the college premises without the written permission of the Principal.
- ◆ Student must behave properly with staff, employee of the college/hospital. Acts of misbehavior will lead to disciplinary action.

- ◆ Any student breaking or damaging any college or hospital property shall be required to pay the cost of repair or replacement. In case of willful damage he/she shall be punished as the college authority may deem fit.
- ◆ In dealing with any breach of discipline, infringement of the rules and regulations mentioned in this prospectus, the Principal may decide or refer it to the College Academic Council /College Disciplinary Committee for appropriate penalty including apology, verbal and/or written withdrawal of scholarship, temporary suspension from the college, removal from the hostel, compulsory migration, expulsion from the college and rustication. Punishment imposed on a student will be recorded in his/her transcript/testimonial.

Students are strictly prohibited to keep fire arms and other weapons in the hostel, college premises or on their person. The possession/use of narcotics is also strictly prohibited. Anyone found in possession of or using narcotics or fire arms will be punished. In case of suspicion, any room can be searched without prior notice.

If any document/information provided by candidate, is found false/fake or fabricated at any stage of MBBS course, the admission will be cancelled.

A student's name may be struck off from the college register under the following circumstances

- i. Remaining absent from classes for more than three months without any information
- ii. Disciplinary ground (on the advice of the Academic council).
- iii. Non-payment of the college dues within three months from the due date of payment.

Others Dues

Examination fees have to be paid as per university regulation and if any international student fail to pass professional exam within the scheduled time of the course, the student must pay US\$ 100 per month with examination fees for the additional time of the course.

Similarly National Students fail to pass Final MBBS Examination within the scheduled time of the course the concerning student must pay tuition fee for the subsequent month with examination fees.

Library rules/regulations

Students are allowed to use the library, Books will be issued to the students only for reading in the library, home issue of books for the students is not permitted, The library rules/regulations framed by the authority to be adhered to by the students.

Student Attendance

Student attendances are recorded in attendance registers, Attendance reports to be sent to the parents/guardians on a quarterly basis. Absentee students without any legal ground will be punished including fine.

Re-Admission

Students must pay their monthly tuition fees in each month, if they fail to pay monthly tuition fees within 15th of each month, they have to pay late fees of Tk 20/- for each day till tuition fees are paid up to three month. The students who will not pay tuition fees for more than three months his/her name shall be struck off from the Attendance Register. If he/she intends to get himself/herself re-admitted after three months he/she will need to pay Tk 2,500/= as fine and will clear up three months arrear tuition fees and other charges/fines applicable for re-admission subject to approval of the Academic Council.

Internship

After passing final professional MBBS examination students have to enrol for one year rotatory internship programme. Within this one year 11 months and 15 days at medical college hospital and 15 days at UHC. Internship Programme is structured and supervised. It is compulsory to complete internship Training to get permanent Registraion from Bangladesh Medical and Dental Council for doing Independent practice.

College Activities :
